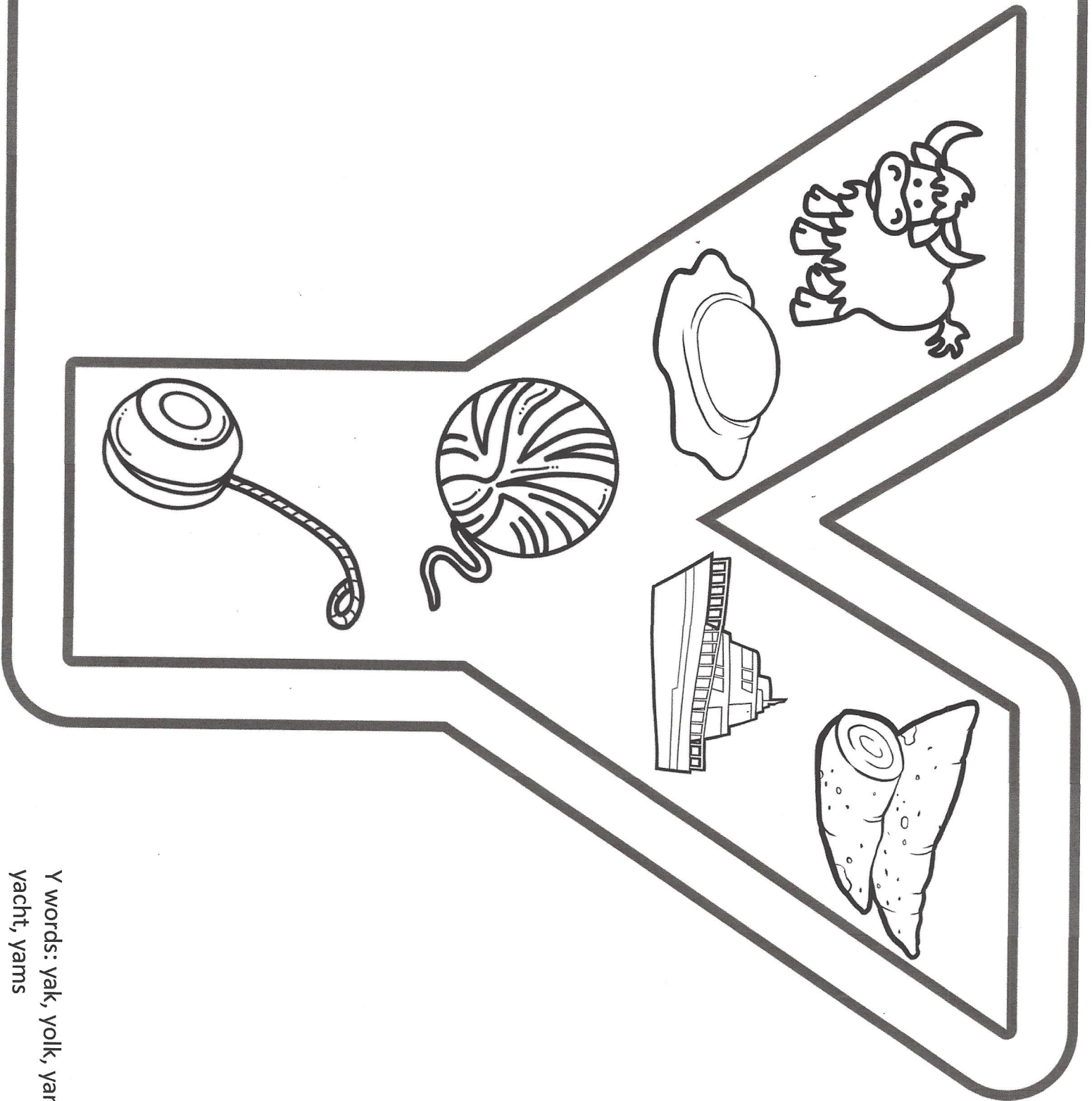

Following directions and increasing vocabulary



1. Using the Y page with pictures in it, review the words that begin with the Y sound to make sure your child knows what each picture is.

- Where is the picture of the Yak? What other animal does it look like (cow, buffalo, bull, etc.)
- What is the middle of an egg called? (the yolk) What color is it? (yellow)
- What is a yam? (it's a kind of potato that tastes sweet) Is it a fruit or a vegetable? (it's a vegetable) What color is a yam? (orange)
- Can you find the yarn? What can you do with yarn? What is made of yarn?
- Do you know what a yacht is? (a very big, fancy boat)
- Where is the yo-yo? What is it? (a toy with a string you use to move it up and down)

2. Give directions one at a time to follow:

- Color the yarn blue
- Color the yak brown
- Color the yolk yellow
- Color the yam orange, etc. (until all pictures are completed)
